## Requirements

- Rebates only available to City of Circle Pines customers.
- Only WaterSense labeled toilet or controller can be used for rebate to be placed on utility account.
- The maximum rebate is \$200.00.
- Installation costs are not eligible for rebates.
- New sprinkler systems are not eligible.
- Documentation of qualification must be provided with application.

- The Landowner must submit a copy of the controller or toilet invoice indicating the total cost and verification of payment and proof of WaterSense labeled controller or toilet.
- Landowner misrepresentation of qualifying information stated on the application will require repayment of grant funds to the City/Utility.
- To the extent there are not sufficient funds to provide for all requests, the unfunded applications will be prioritized with money going to those that provide the greatest amount of water savings.
- The City reserves the right to inspect the products for proper installation.

## **Conditions of Payment & Customer Agreement**

My signature indicates that the information provided is true. I have read and understood the rebate program guidelines, and that I comply with the City of Circle Pines rebate program requirements. Upon compliance, a rebate will be distributed as a credit to my utility account if funding is available.

All services provided by the Landowner pursuant to this grant shall be performed to the satisfaction of the City/Utilities, as determined at the sole discretion of the City/Utilities. The Landowner shall not receive payment, and the City /Utilities is entitled to a complete reimbursement, for work found by the City/Utilities to be unsatisfactory, or performed in violation of federal, state or local law, ordinance, rule or regulations.
