

Water Conservation Tips

If you are looking for ideas on how you can conserve water, here are a few tips:

1. Don't let the faucet run when brushing your teeth.
2. Fix leaking toilets.
3. Take shorter showers.
4. Only run washing machines and dishwashers when they are full.
5. Reuse water, when possible.
6. Never pour oil or grease down the drain.
7. Use toilet for its intended use. Do not use for trash or tissues.

Recognize Signs of a Gas Pipeline Leak

Leaks from a natural gas pipeline are extremely rare. However, it is important to know how to recognize the signs of a leak if one were to occur in your area.

Call Centennial Utilities right away if you notice:

- > a "rotten egg" smell from the odorant added to the natural gas;
- > vegetation over or near the pipeline which appears to be dead or dying for no apparent reason;
- > water bubbling at a creek, pond, river or any wet area;
- > dirt being blown or appearing thrown into the air;
- > flames or vapors near the pipeline;
- > exposed pipeline, which may have been caused by a natural disaster;
- > hissing, whistling or roaring sound.

Do not go near the area and keep others away from the site. Do not operate anything that may ignite a gas leak, including cellular phones, flashlights, lighters or two-way radios. Do not move equipment or vehicles in the area as turning them on may also ignite a gas leak. If a vehicle is running, do not turn it off. Do not attempt to shut off any valves or extinguish fires.

Store Flammables Away From Gas Appliances

Store flammable liquids away from natural gas appliances. Flammable liquids include cleaning solvents, gasoline, contact cement, paint and varnish. They give off vapors which can easily ignite if exposed to any source of ignition, such as an electrical spark or pilot light on a natural gas appliance.

Keep all flammable materials at a safe distance from sources of ignition and use only in open, well-vented areas.
