Call Before You Dig

Report any planned excavation in your yard by contacting Gopher State One Call at gopherstateonecall.org or by calling 811. It's the law to use this free service to notify GSOC at least two days before you dig so that all utilities are marked.

Some utilities are just inches below the surface and striking them can cause property damage, injuries or death.

Customer-owned Gas Lines are Potentially Hazardous

Customer-owned gas lines that are located after the gas meter and are underground running to an adjoining building or a gas grill or other gas appliance may be a hazard. These lines have the potential to corrode and result in a gas leak.

Individuals with these underground lines are responsible for maintaining them. Steel lines need to be cathodically protected to avoid corrosion.

Copper and other lines may also be subject to decay. It is extremely important that if you smell gas outdoors where these lines exist, you call Centennial Utilities at 763-784-6751 or 763-427-1212 after hours - ask for Centennial Utilities to further investigate the gas smell. You may also call 911 and ask for Centennial Utilities.

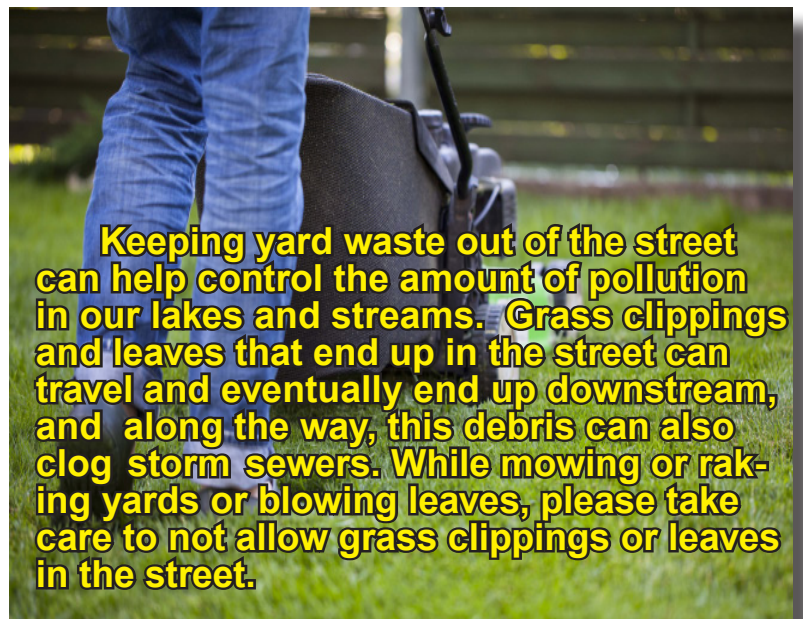
